In 1997 Lyngdoh received the WWF Prince Bernhard Scholarship for Environmental Leadership from Geneva. After this experience he moved to New York and joined the Commission on Sustainable Development Secretariat at United Nations and worked with different major groups of Agenda 21. In 2001 Lyngdoh joined the Permanent Mission of India and worked with the UN Ambassador's office and after graduating from Columbia University's School of International and Public Affairs in 2002 with a degree in Environmental Policy Studies he worked with the World Environment Center developing their Corporate Social Responsibility protocols to guide business and industry reach their triple-bottomline and sustainable development goals. Lyngdoh joined the Environment Department of the World Bank in 2003. Lyngdoh completed his post graduate research work on analysing the relationships between Sustainable Forest Management and Rural Livelihood Strategies at the Development Studies Institute of the London School of Economics and Political Science in 2007. He is the Co-founder of the Global Youth Action Network and sits on the Board of Directors of PCI Media Impact.
